

2026 Horse Skillathon Study Guide

The Horse Skillathon is for all exhibitors exhibiting Equine including Horses, Ponies, and Donkeys.

Divisions for Skillathons are based on years in the project.

The Lucas County Fair Horse Skillathon will take place on Monday, July 13, at the Fairgrounds.

This Study Guide describes each station that will be in the Horse Skillathon.

Station 1: PARTS OF A HORSE IDENTIFICATION

Identify parts of the horse. According by skill level.

Station 2: FEED & HAY IDENTIFICATION

Identify fed and hay samples.

Station 3: Body Conditioning Identification

Identify body conditions of horses.

Station 4: Horse Coat Colors Identification

Identify 10 different coat colors.

Station 5: Parts of a Western Saddle and Bridle

You will have to identify parts of a western saddle (18 points) and bridle (7 points)

Station 6: Recite

You will need to recite the 4-H Pledge, Motto and Slogan.

Station 7: Interview Station

Interview of your project with a volunteer.
