

Lucas County 4-H Scholarships

The Lucas County 4-H Advisory Council may award up to five full scholarships for any of the following sponsored 4-H Camps; Ohio Leadership Camp, Citizen Washington Focus, Sea Camp, Conservation and Space Camp. See ohio4h.org/4-h-camps for dates and further information. If you have other camping opportunities contact the 4-H Advisory Council. Scholarship availability will be dependent on available funds generated thru the 4-H Café. Advisory Committee Members will review applications and award scholarships based on the following criteria.

- Age 14-18 as of January 1 of current year.
- Current active Lucas County 4-H member.
- 20 community service hours; can be done anywhere, signed verification with title and contact information.
- Previous work in 4-H Café or outdoor café during fair week, minimum 10 hours. Contact Robin Reimer for past work verification.
- Attend at least one Jr. Fair Board meeting.
- Assist in fix up or clean up days at fairgrounds.
- Letter of Recommendation from unrelated 4-H advisor.
- If awarded, delegate will present a verbal or written report at the 4-H Awards Banquet sharing their trip experience.
- Display will be exhibited at the Fair in the Stucco Building based on campers learning experience.

Scholarship applications are to be sent to the Extension Office and are due **March 11th**

Interviews will be conducted by the Lucas County 4-H Advisory Council the following week. Scholarships will be announced on the following Friday.

Members may receive 1 full scholarship per year. Members may apply and attend additional camps at own expense. Additional scholarships are also available from the 4-H office for Leadership Camp.
