About \$martPath:

- \$martPath is a free, engaging, interactive and easy-to-use way for elementary school teachers (grades 1-6) to embed economic and financial lessons in their classrooms
- All \$martPath units of study are relevant and deliver on standards in social studies, math and financial literacy
- Many online resources are developed for only teacher use or only student use, \$martPath was designed to be a teacher-lead, classroom experience
- Flexibility is a critical component. Teachers have free access to every grade level within 1st – 6th grade. There are three classroom lessons per grade that use online videos, classroom discussion and activities.
- \$martPath is completely free and any teacher can sign up to use it

\$martPath training 2017:

Any teacher is welcome to sign up for the free online resource but if you want to attend a training in Lucas County (in order to qualify for the financial incentives) there is a different sign-up process.

- Your school can schedule a one and half hour training to be held at your site.
- Minimum of four teachers (any grades) to schedule a free training.
- Teachers receive: \$75 gift card for attending the training workshop and a \$75 gift card after implementing the financial education program in the classroom
