Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)



1 // Do I qualify for SNAP?

You may qualify if your household's gross monthly income is at or under 130% of the 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines. Benefits are based on net income and family size.

What is SNAP?

SNAP, formerly called food stamps, is a federal program that helps people buy the food they need for healthy lives. SNAP provides benefits to eligible individuals and families via an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card.

The Ohio Direction EBT card can be used like a debit card to purchase groceries in authorized retail food stores and farmers markets. The amount you receive each month depends on your income and family size.

2// What do I need to apply?

Your county Job and Family Services (JFS) office handles SNAP applications. You might need any of the following documents:

- Proof of identity (Drivers License, State ID, Passport)
- Social Security card
- Proof of any income you receive
- Proof of assets, such as bank account statements
- Proof of housing costs and address
- Proof of disability (if you claim it)
- Permanent Resident Card or other immigration documents if not a US citizen

3// What happens next?

You can apply online at https://ssp.benefits.ohio.gov or you can complete a paper application and submit it to your local JFS office.

Answer as many questions as you can. If you are unsure about an answer, leave it blank and submit anyway to get the process started.

You will receive a notice from JFS with the date and time of your phone interview to verify your application.

You will be able to submit documents via mail, email, or in person. A determination of benefits will happen within 30 days.

4// What can I buy with SNAP?

Look for stores that have the Ohio Direction logo on their doors or windows. Some may have posters saying, "SNAP EBT accepted here."

You can buy food (fruits, vegetables, poultry, meat, fish, dairy products, cereals, breads, other snack foods, non-alcoholic beverages) as well as seeds or plants to grow food.

SNAP cannot be used to buy:

- Beer, wine, liquor, cigarettes, tobacco
- Vitamins, supplements, medicines
- Hot foods or foods heated in store
- Pet food
- Paper products
- Cleaning supplies
- Cosmetics and hygiene items

5// What other options are available?

Online Shopping and Delivery

Ohio Direction Card users can use an online ordering service (like Instacart) to order their food and pick up curbside or in some cases have food delivered.

Produce Perks

Ohio Direction Cards are also accepted at select farmers markets across Ohio.

The Produce Perks program provides a \$1-for-\$1 match on fruit and vegetable purchases using SNAP/EBT (limit \$25 per day).

- Visit the farmers market information booth before you shop.
- Determine how much you want to spend in SNAP dollars. Swipe your EBT card. You will receive SNAP tokens and an equal amount of Produce Perks tokens.
- Tokens are like cash- they cannot be replaced and do not expire!

Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)



What is WIC?

The Ohio WIC program is administered by the Ohio Department of Health. WIC helps income eligible pregnant and breastfeeding women, women who recently had a baby, infants, and children who are at health risk due to inadequate nutrition.

WIC provides supplemental, highly nutritious foods such as cereal, eggs, milk, whole grain foods, fruits and vegetables, and iron-fortified infant formula; education and support services, and referrals to prenatal and pediatric health care programs.

1 // Do I qualify for WIC?

Are you a pregnant or breastfeeding woman? A woman who recently gave birth? A child under age 5?

You may qualify if your household's gross monthly income is at or under 185% of the 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

2// What do I need to apply?

Your county WIC offices handle WIC applications. You might need any of the following documents:

- Proof of identity and Ohio residency (Drivers License, State ID, Passport)
- · Proof of Income
- Statement from health professionals of medical/nutritional risk
- Verification of pregnancy

3// What happens next?

You will need to schedule an appointment with your local WIC office (see other side for contact information).

At your appointment, bring all of your necessary documents with you. If you are applying on behalf of a child, the child must be present at the appointment as well.

At the appointment, a doctor, nurse or nutritionist will determine if you have any medical risks. Risks can include poor diet, anemia, being underweight, being pregnant at 35 or older, a history of pregnancy complications or other medical challenges.

Ohio WIC is considered a short-term program.
Depending on the persons condition, either pregnant, postpartum, breastfeeding, an infant or child, an eligible person usually receives benefits from 6 months to a year, at which time they are required to re-apply.

4// What do I receive with WIC?

Check the WIC Authorized Food List, as only specific brands are allowed for purchase. Use your WIC nutrition card at participating retailers.

Depending on your status (pregnant, breastfeeding, postpartum) and your child's status (under 12 months, age 1-5) the monthly food package will vary. Items include:

- Infant Formula
- 100% Fruit or Vegetable juice
- Dairy Foods: Cow milk, Soy milk, Yogurt, Cheese
- Whole Grains: Brown rice, Oatmeal, Whole wheat pasta, Tortillas, Whole wheat bread and buns, Cereal

- Protein: Eggs, Tofu, Peanut butter, Canned tuna, Dried or canned beans
- Fruits and Vegetables: Cash voucher for any combination of fresh, frozen, or canned
 - Children \$25
 - Pregnant/Postpartum \$44
 - Breastfeeding \$49

WIC Shopper App

Install "WicShopper" on your phone or tablet from your app store. Select Ohio as your WIC agency.

When you shop, scan products using the app to verify it is a WIC allowed food.

The app also tracks your benefits available, provides recipes, nutrition education, and other resources.

Benefits

 The WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) provides WIC participants with four \$5 coupons redeemable for Ohio grown fresh fruits, vegetables and herbs from authorized farmers at farmers' markets and farm stands. This program is available in 69 Ohio counties.



Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)

What is Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)?

The SFMNP provides low-income seniors with coupons that can be exchanged for eligible foods at farmers' markets, roadside stands, and community supported agriculture (CSA) programs. Eligible older adults will receive ten \$5 coupons valid until October 31, 2023.

Who is eligible for SFMNP benefits?

In order to participate, the individual must meet the following requirements:

- Be 60 years or older by June 1, 2023
- Be a resident of Lucas county or surrounding Ohio counties
- Have an annual income of not more than 185% of the Federal poverty income quidelines:

\$0 - \$25,142 if you live alone

\$0 - \$33,874 for a household of two

How do I use my coupons in Lucas County?

2023 coupons should be mailed out in late June, in time for the local harvests in July, August, and September. Participants can choose from a variety of great fruits and vegetables, including apples, corn, zucchini, cabbage, tomatoes and more! Honey and fresh herbs are also eligible for purchase with SFMNP coupons.

Your coupons are welcome at many local venues, including the Toledo Farmers Market Downtown and at Westgate, Sylvania Farmers Market, Perrysburg Farmers Market, and several local farm markets. A list of available vendors is included in your coupon packet.

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) works to improve the health of low-income persons at least 60 years of age by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA Foods.
